Marjorie and I are so looking forward to spending July and August with you all. We first visited your church back in 2013 and have taken a keen interest in your journey with the Lord ever since.








We meet to pray every Tuesday night at 7:30-8:00pm on Zoom. It's just 30 mins and it is a great time of powerful prayer and encouragement!
